







Minutes of Meeting:

#### **Item No: 1 Review of Previous Council Minutes and Actions**

Governing Body members reviewed the deliberations made on various issues in the previous meeting and actions in respect of the aspects like Increase of intake, Result Analysis, Vision and Mission & and its dissemination methods administrative policies and other infrastructural developments.

#### **Item No: 2 Report and suggestions on Academics, Events and Admissions**

The members received a report on academic, other activities and events in the college and expressed their satisfaction with the progress made by the college during the present academic year. However the following activities are suggested:

1. Innovative practices in Laboratory.
2. Exclusive Technology workshops, online training classes, and webinars like ‘Spoken tutorial’
3. Hobby projects
4. Hand books for execution of academics

The committee members discussed about the different teaching Methodologies and suggested to implement pedagogical initiatives. Mrs. V. Nagumani emphasized to follow these pedagogical initiatives for effective teaching and learning and suggested inculcates the regular practice of using the Self Learning facilities including Digital Library, institutional repository. And Dr Susma suggested to go for e-Learning Solutions and Two-way HD Delivery Mechanism for Teachers and Students (eLSDM), an online learning resource supported by JNUTH.

#### **Item No.3 .Long term goals**

It is proposed and decided by the council to have the following long term goals:

1. Accreditations like NAAC and/or NBA should be done in 5 years
2. MoUs with Industry should be done in large number in each department

#### **Item No: 4 Career Guidance**

The Governing Council has directed the Principal to strengthen Career guidance Cell by preparing strategic plan for training, which should emphasize on Campus Recruitment Training (CRT) and career guidance workshops & other activities which will improve knowledge of a student about the bright career.

#### **Item No: 5 Industry interactions & Internships**

The Governing Body showed the deep concern in promoting the Industry interactions & Internships in all the departments to excel the students for quality in Project Based Learning in different specializations & Domains so as to enrich with skills and ability of the students to gain an proactive knowledge.

Dr. R RadhaKrishna advised Principal to have more interactions with industry by increasing the number of MoU's, Conducting Industrial Visits, sending students and Faculty for training programs and inviting eminent resource persons to deliver the programs in the institution

#### **Item No: 6 Research and Development Activities**

The Governing Body recommended the following R&D related initiatives:

- a. Incubation Activities in the Laboratory / elementary research
- b. Intensifying Professional body activities by channelizing the departmental association activities.
- c. Research Promotion Schemes or incentive schemes
- d. Encouraging Publications through incentives.
- e. Consultancy and Sponsored activities to be enhanced for the effective utilization of the resources and raise funds for the future endeavors.

Also, Dr C Radhakrishna advised to make use of faculty specialized skills and expertise levels in the activities of developing useful products for the societal needs and enable the academic research work with the students.
