**Minutes of Meeting:**

**Item No: 1 Review and Actions on Previous Minutes**

Governing Body members reviewed the deliberations made on various issues in the previous meeting and actions are suggested on following issues:

**Item No: 2 Research & Development**

Dr. C Radhakrishna, Industrialist & Technologist suggested to promote the research centers so as to enhance the student's technical skills and bridge the gap between Academic and Industry to excelling in academic services.

Dr. M Sushma added her voice to motivate students and faculty to do research activities with their creativity and innovative ideas and to publish in the technical magazines and Newsletter's on website.

**Item No: 3 Activities of Departmental Associations and Professional Chapters**
